Dave Chamberlain has a B.S. in mechanical engineering from the University of New Hampshire (1984) and an M.S. in mechanical engineering from Northeastern University (1989). He is a registered Professional Engineer in the state of Massachusetts, a Certified Energy Manager (CEM) and Certified Green Building Engineer with the Association of Energy Engineers (AEE). He worked as a mechanical engineer for Raytheon Company in Sudbury, MA, from 1985-1991, then as a general engineer for the U.S. Department of Energy in Boston, MA, from 1991-1997.

Mr. Chamberlain is currently employed by Raytheon Company as a principal energy engineer. He is responsible for energy management in the Integrated Defense Systems (IDS) business unit, which includes 5 million square feet of office, laboratory and manufacturing facilities. He also plays a key role with Raytheon's Enterprise Energy Team, and manages Raytheon's ENERGY STAR partnership with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and U.S. Department of Energy. Mr. Chamberlain also serves as co-chair for the Energy Management Council of the Associated Industries of Massachusetts (AIM).
