At M.J. Bradley, Ann served as Chief of the Environmental Protection Division in the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office under Scott Harshbarger, where she also exercised joint oversight of the Massachusetts Environmental Strike Force. She worked as a legal services attorney in Seattle immediately after law school, and then as a partner in the litigation department at the Boston law firm Goulston & Storrs.
